Legislative Assembly.

28TH DAY—June 30th.

MORNING SESSION—CONTINUED. From the same committee he reported on the petitions to remove from office, and keep on, Mr. T. A. Lloyd as road supervisor of Koolau. They report that they have investigated the matter and find that Mr. Lloyd is the best road supervisor the Government has ever had in that district, and therefore recommend that both petitions be laid on the table. Adopted.

RESOLUTIONS AND BILLS. Minister Thurston read a first time bill to encourage the cultivation of coffee, and to prevent the introduction of coffee leaf disease. Referred to Printing Committee.

ORDER OF THE DAY. Third reading of a bill to authorize the Hawaiian Government to contract for a sub-marine electric telegraph cable. Passed.

Third reading of a bill to provide for the payment of the expenses of the Government until after the passage of the Appropriation Bill.

Noble Smith moved to insert that the Minister of Finance be authorized to pay the back salaries of the 3rd and 4th Justices of the Supreme Court.

Rep. Kalauka moved to refer to a select committee. Lost. The vote on Noble Smith's motion was a tie, and the chair put in the casting vote for the motion. The bill then passed as amended.

Minister Thurston moved to reconsider the vote. Rep. C. Brown said he had grave doubts about the constitutionality of the bill, and if they were going to tinker it they had better commence at the beginning, from the title down to the last clause.

Noble Young was in favor of reconsidering, so that all parties could be benefited. The motion to reconsider was carried.

The Minister of Interior amended Noble Smith's amendment by including all employees in the Government who have not been paid.

Rep. C. Brown moved that the title be amended, to read: To provide for the payment of salaries, expenses of court, and other expenses of the Government until July 31, 1888.

Noble Townsend moved that the bill with the amendments be referred to the Judiciary Committee.

Noble Richardson moved to strike out all the amendments and leave the bill as it was.

The bill was referred to the Judiciary Committee. The House then adjourned until 10 a. m. Monday.

29TH DAY—July 2. MORNING SESSION. The House opened at 10 a. m. President W. R. Castle in the Chair. Roll called and absentees noted.

PETITIONS. Sundry petitions were presented and appropriately referred.

RESOLUTIONS AND BILLS. Rep. Kamaoia read for the first time a bill to amend section 280 of the Civil Code, and section 3 chapter 59 of the Penal Code, to make them read alike. Referred to Judiciary Committee.

Rep. Paelele offered a resolution to the effect that \$1,000 be inserted in the Appropriation Bill for a bridge at Halawa, Molokai. Laid on the table to be considered with the Appropriation Bill.

ORDER OF THE DAY. Third reading of the Military Bill. The bill passed.
