ELDER MAWS TAKES A HAND. EDITOR BULLET NI-

In your resul of Sept 21 non-corr est and much esteemed irrend Dr. Hammond, in his Zeal for the overthrow of men-made creeds and dogmas, unintentionally we presume, overlooked us as preachers of the everlasting gospel in its fulness and our organization as the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ, when he made the unqualified and misleading statements in asking and answering the following very important questions: "Who preaches or proclams the gospel plan of salvation as given by Christ and preached by the Apostles?" Where are the pastors of the churches who command believers in Christ to be immersed for the remission of sins as did Ananias?

The above statements I am glad to say are only applicable to the popular men-made and so called Caristian churches and their manisters. But we as ministers of the true church o Jesus Christ and preachers of the whole gospel, without purse or scrip, do most positively and emphatically deny the charges set forth by Dr Hammond, as they are untruthful when applied to us as ministers or as a church. For we claim to be the restored and Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ and we defy Dr Hammond or any other man to show any discrepancy whatever in organization, doctrines or practice, between us and the church organized by Christ and His apostles. We therefore demand that Dr. Hammond as a Bible believer, a christian gentleman, and a lover of Christ put into practice Christ's commands. "As ye would that men should do to you do ye also to them likewise - " Luke 6:31-and either publicly retract the above statements which are an injustice to us as ministers and as the Church of Jesus Christ, or meet uin Christian debate and affirm his statements with Bible proofs, or I fear he will be branded as one who preaches by precept and not by ex ample. Dr. Hammond, the world is full of precept men; show your lovfor Christ by doing us justice, or meeting us and proving your asser-

tions true. In conclusion we will ask some questions and offer a reward. Dr Hammond and our Advent friend. Mr. Burgess, and other Protestantare down on the Popes and claim to stick to the Bible for their guide, and yet they must turn away from the Bible and look to the Pope of Rom for their authority and example is believe in and establish churches without apostles and prophets as officers, and to leave out the doctrinof laying on of hands for the gift of the Holy Ghost. For their Biblrecognizes only a church organized with these officers, who were put there by God himself as the following passages: 1 Cor. 12:28, "And God hath set some in the church. first apostles, secondarily prophets,' and again Ephesians 4: 11, 12, 13. "And he gave some apostles, and some prophets, and some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers; for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ (the Church) till we all come in the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God into a perfeet man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ,' This unity and perfection has not been attained to by the churches of to-day, therefore apostles and prephets are necessary and should be in the church for the work of the ministry, as also the laying on of hands and all other doctrines and gifts which it pleased God to put in the church as you will find in Heb. 6:2-"Of the doctrine of baptisms and of laying on of bands," and again in Acts 8:17-"Then laid they their hands on them and they received the Holy Ghost," and also in Acts 19:6-"And when Paul had laid his hands upon them the Holy Ghost came upon them." The beloved disciple John says in his second epistle and minth verse: "Whosoever transgresseth and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ he hath both the Father and the Son." Why will people follow and obey the example of the Popes of Rome instead of Christ?
