**ELDER HAWS TAKES A HAND.**

EDITOR BULLETIN:—

In your issue of Sept. 21, 1891, I

read and much esteemed friend Dr.

Hammond, in his zeal for the over-

throw of men-made creeds and dog-

mas, unintentionally we presume,

overlooked us as preachers of the

everlasting gospel in its fulness and

our organization as the Reorganized

Church of Jesus Christ, when he

made the unqualified and misleading

statements in asking and answering

the following very important ques-

tions: "Who preaches or proclaims

the gospel plan of salvation as given

by Christ and preached by the Ap-

ostles?" He repeats the question,

"But who preaches this gospel?"

And answers positively and emphati-

cally, "None." He then says: "Go

into any of our churches, look around,

but few Bibles are to be seen in the

hands of the congregation. An elo-

quent essay carefully read is attract-

ing their attention. The subject of

the essay is not, 'What shall I do to

be saved?' It is an essay on astro-

nomomy, botany, 'Is the Bible true?' or

some similar subject. Doctrines of

men are taught for the command-

ments of God. A large salary is the

sure evidence that God has called the

man to be pastor of the church. God

calls loudest where the biggest salary

is offered. Is it not the case that too

many preachers are afraid to preach

the doctrines of the Bible lest their

salary be diminished? Where are the

pastors of the churches who command

believers in Christ to be immersed for

the remission of sins as did Ananias?"

The above statements I am glad to

say are only applicable to the popular

men-made and so-called Christian

churches and their ministers. But

we as ministers of the true church of

Jesus Christ and preachers of the

whole gospel, without purse or scrip,

do most positively and emphatically

deny the charges set forth by Dr.

Hammond, as they are untruthful

when applied to us as ministers or as

a church. For we claim to be the

restored and Reorganized Church of

Jesus Christ and we defy Dr.

Hammond or any other man to

show any discrepancy whatever in

organization, doctrines or practice,

between us and the church organized

by Christ and His apostles. We

therefore demand that Dr. Hammond

as a Bible believer, a Christian gen-

tleman, and a lover of Christ put into

practice Christ's commands. "As-

ye would that men should do to you

ye also do to them likewise." Luke

6:31—and either publicly retract the

above statements which are an in-

justice to us as ministers and as the

Church of Jesus Christ, or meet us

in Christian debate and affirm his

statements with Bible proofs, or I

fear he will be branded as one who

preaches by precept and not by ex-

ample. Dr. Hammond, the world is

full of precept men; show your love

for Christ by doing us justice, or

meeting us and proving your asser-

tions true.

In conclusion we will ask some

questions and offer a reward. Dr.

Hammond and our Advent friend,

Mr. Burgess, and other Protestants

are down on the Pope and claim to

stick to the Bible for their guide, and

yet they must turn away from the

Bible and look to the Pope of Rome

for their authority and example to

believe in and establish churches

without apostles and prophets as

officers, and to leave out the doctrine

of laying on of hands for the gift of
