Salisbury's Reply to the United States

New York, Jan. 19.—A special to the Journal and Advertiser from Washington says: The essential points in the tentative answer of Lord Salisbury to the demand made on him by Ambassador Choate for a declaration of policy and a concession of liability in the matter of the seizures of American flour in cargoes on the Mashona, the Beatrice and the Maria are:

The United States accepts Great Britain's offer to pay American citizens in interest the face value of the cargoes, with a reasonable profit Great Britain's plea in justification is regarded as inadequate and evasive in that it avoids a general declaration as to whether corn, meal and flour are contraband of war, but the answer is reasonably sufficient because it declares specifically that the articles on the vessels named were not contraband of war as they were not destined for the camp of the enemy and that was one important contention of the State Department.

As to the third proposition, the United States accepts in good faith the plea that the goods were seized as a military necessity for the supply of the British army and navy and that such necessity justified the act of seizure without prejudice to any other international questions involved.

Davidson of Neepawa, provincial treasurer, minister of agriculture and immigration and commissioner of provincial lands; D. R. McFadden, Emerson, provincial secretary and minister of public works; R. P. Roblin, Woodlands and James Johnson, Turtle Mountain, ministers without portfolios.
