Chinese War Causes Reduction in Trade

St. Paul, July 19.—The Great Northern has given out 17 all its agents not to contract any freight for China destined to the interior points beyond Shanghai, Hongkong and Canton.

The Great Northern and Northern Pacific will feel, to some extent, the immediate effects of the Chinese anti-foreign uprising.

A railroad official said today that the Great Northern might temporarily lose its trans-Pacific connections in case the Chinese war reached an acute stage.

The Northern Pacific operates its own ships from China and Japan and would not be subject to the same difficulty.

Something About a Character Whom Lowell Satisfied.

John P. Robinson, the subject of one of James Russell Lowell's "Hoson Biglow's" satires, was a brilliant lawyer of the town of Lowell, a scholarly gentleman and a wit.

In 1842 he received the Whig nomination for Whig candidate, as the Liberty party had then begun to present nominees against it.

A few years later, after General Caleb Cushing had been in the Mexican war, he was nominated by the Democrats as their candidate for governor of Massachusetts, upon which Mr. Robinson wrote a letter declaring he should leave the Whig party and support General Cushing.
