The Mongolia docked at 2:49 o'clock this afternoon. She brought a large list of passengers for Honolulu, among them being Attorney Lewis, A. W. T. Bottomley, Mr. Humburg and many others.

The Mongolia was delayed in docking, having broken one of her bow lines. She came pretty nearly bumping into one of the Inter-island steamers, which was docked on the canal side.

Lau Yau, a Chinese millionaire who has been touring the world with his family, arrived and while here will be the guest of the Chinese Consul, who was at the wharf.

Mr. Otsuka arrived from New York to become the sub-manager of the Yokohama Specie Bank, supplanting Mr. Ohtani, who leaves for Japan on the Hongkong Maru on May 2.

The Mongolia brought 100 tons of cargo and 191 bags of mail for Honolulu. She leaves at 10 a. m. tomorrow.
