But things have happened since then and it is stated that the new reservoir will be finished and full of water inside of six months.

The services of Mr. Vincent, an organizer of such institutions, have been secured and work of getting together the proper timber for the coming orchestra has been started. An orchestra, consisting of thirty members, was organized three years ago, and it is hoped to turn out a still larger and better one this year.
