RUSSIANS GIVEN ONE HOUR

Imprisonment for one hour in the office of Marshal Hendry was the sentence pronounced this morning by Judge Robertson in the Federal Court against Alexander Gabrieloff, Gregorio Potaplanka and Savell Saitshuk the three Russians who were accused of trespassing on United States Quarantine Reservation.

These men were arrested on June 18 and have been held since that time in jail, pleading not guilty to the charge against them.

Attorney Bittling was appointed last week to appear for the men when their case was to be set for trial today, and upon his advice each man expressed a desire to change his plea to one of guilty.

PROCLAMATION FOR ELECTION

Gives Precinct Changes And Numbers To Be Elected

Late Saturday afternoon Governor Frear signed the proclamation for the general election in which several precinct changes have been made.

One precinct has been added to West Hawaii, being the twelfth of the second and comprising a portion of the old third.

On Maui the eighth precinct has been abolished, this territory being divided between the seventh and ninth.

One precinct has been added to the fourth district, being known as the twelfth of the fourth and being bounded by the tenth, third, fourth and fifth precincts.

In the fifth district two new precincts have been made, one at Watertown and the other at Wahiawa.

The proclamation calls for the election of two senators from Hawaii, one from Maui, four from Oahu including one to fill the unexpired term of Frank Harvey, deceased, and one senator from Kauai.

Representatives to be elected are four from both the first and second districts, six from the third, fourth and fifth, and four from the sixth.

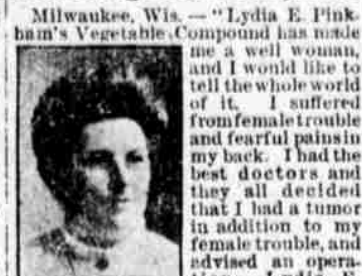
