

"Who is this Mary?" the Communists asked at a recent trial of Chinese members of the Legion of Mary. On answering: "She is the Mother of Jesus." The Communist judge answered, "No! She is somewhere in Shanghai where she is directing you; we shall not rest until we lay a hand on her."

A Catholic girl, aged 9, was seized by the Communists in China and told to lead a procession of the other Catholic girls in the Missions to the latrine. There she was told to drop therein her medal of the Blessed Mother. Upon refusing the Communists seized her father, brought both of them to the Communion rail of the Church where they were threatened with death. This failing, they took the girl to a public platform, made her kneel and as she clutched the medal of the Blessed Mother in her hand, hundreds of pagan children were ordered by the Communists to file in procession before her to spit in her face.

At Nanking, a child was caught with a prayer book containing a picture of Our Lady. "Who is this" asked the Communists.
