Notice is hereby given that Henry Smith James R. Thompson and Oliver J. McConnell, whose postoffice address is Butte, Montana, have this day filed their application for a patent for 81.55 linear feet, being 80 feet westerly and 73.55 feet easterly from the point of discovery in tunnel of the Little Mississippi Lode Mining claim, upon which a notice of intention applied for patent was posted on the 23rd day of April, A. D., 1902, situated in

Summit Valley, unorganized mining district of Liberty County, State of Montana, described and surveyed No. 1666, north 1/4 section 17, Range 7 west, being more particularly described, as follows, to-wit:
