WRECKS ON SEA AND LAKE.

The Seafaring Man Beset by Dangers That Are Hard to Avoid.

New York, Nov. 15.—The British bark Kate F. Troop, Capt. Smith, which arrived to-day from Singapore, brought to port the captain and crew of the Italian bark Torquato, of Castellar, abandoned at sea Nov. 7 in a sinking condition. Capt. Trampant, of the lost vessel, reported that he sailed from Genoa, Aug. 18, for New York, with a cargo of marble and rags. The vessel experienced a series of heavy gales soon after passing through the Strait of Gibraltar.

Bad weather continued, and on the morning of Oct. 26 the wind suddenly shifted to the southeast, gradually increasing in fury. At 7 a.m. it blew a hurricane, lasting for several hours, and the little bark sprung a leak. It was very evident that the vessel was doomed. Signals of distress were kept hoisted daily. The crew kept faithfully at the pumps, and just as they were despairing of rescue, a sail was sighted to leeward. She proved to be the British bark, Troop. Capt. Smith had just previously observed the distressed vessel's signal. All were taken on board and she continued on her voyage.

London, Nov. 15.—The British ship Culmore, Capt. Rhodo, foundered sixty miles off Spurnhead, county York, yesterday. Twenty persons were drowned. The Culmore registered 1,629 tons. She hailed from Londonderry, and was owned by Thomas Dicks & Co.

Grand Haven, Mich., Nov. 15.—The small schooner, Antelope, of Chicago, capsized off here today, and three sailors were drowned. The schooner Alert went ashore and will probably go to pieces. The crew was rescued after a hard fight by the life saving crew.

Chicago, Nov. 15.—The schooner D. S. Austin was sunk off Ludington, Mich., last night. The crew of seven were rescued by a life saving crew. The schooner Apprentice Boy was also beached at Ludington. No lives lost.

WISDOM'S VOICE.

Raised to Explain the Conditions Existing in the Territory.

Washington, Nov. 15.—The annual report of Indian Agent Wisdom, at Muskogee, I. T., to the Indian office, throws considerable light upon the conditions in the territory which have resulted in troubles of considerable moment in the Indian country, such as the reign of terror caused by bands of robbers and marauders. He points out, in the first place, the necessity of the enlargement of the courts in Indian Territory. As one of the evils to be eradicated, Wisdom points out land-grabbing. The Indian is satisfied with a small tract of land, but those who have intermarried with Indian women have fenced in and apportioned to their own use thousands of acres. Land is held in common.

He says: "The Indians are reluctant to break up their tribal relations, and to assume the status of United States citizens with attending responsibilities. If I am not mistaken, however, the consensus of opinion among Indians is that some change is inevitable, and that, too, in the near future."
