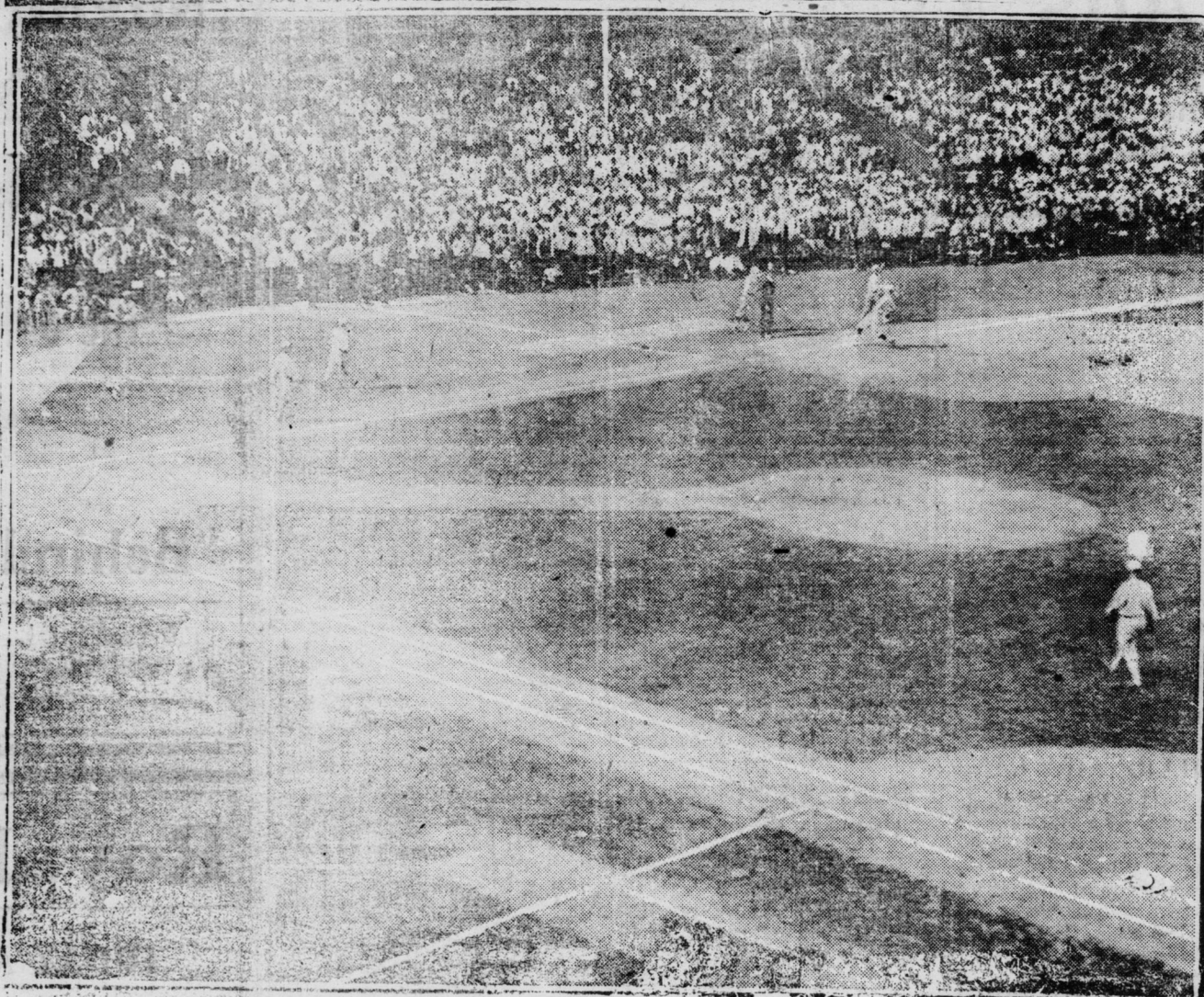

### SONORA ITEMS

Distillation of mescal on a grand scale will be resumed shortly at Alamos, it is reported, from information received yesterday from the government of Sonora. A large number of appliances and apparatus such as is used in such distillation having passed Nogales Monday, en route to Alamos.

The state congress of Nuevo Leon has canvassed the returns from the recent election in that state, declaring the result to be election of Gen. Jose de los Santos to be governor.

Mr. Ignacio Bonillas, ambassador from Mexico to the United States, has departed from Washington to the City of Mexico, for a conference with President Carranza, after which, it is rumored, Mr. Bonillas will be announced a candidate for the presidency of Mexico.

President Carranza has created a board of censors of cinematographic representations in the republic, the aim being to prohibit exhibition of

dramas and comedies offensive to the dignity and decorum of the republic. From this time no films imported from other countries will be permitted to exhibit in Mexico without having passed the censorship.

Visiting Nogales is Engineer Luis L. Leon, from Novojoa.

With date of October 2, Sr. Aquileo Juarez was appointed administrator of customs at Progreso, Yucatan.

During the month of August there passed across the line at Nogales more than 2000 agricultural laborers en route to Imperial Valley in California and Salt River Valley in Arizona, to work under contract in the cotton fields.

From the City of Mexico it is reported that the great automobile factory of Henry Ford, in Detroit, Mich., U. S. A., has requested that there be sent there seventeen youths from Mexico, who desire to become apprentices to the trade or vocation of manufacturing autos and tractors, to fit them to return to Mexico for important employment in the factories that are to be established there by the Ford interests. It is reported that the first factory will be established at Monterey, at a cost of one million dollars.

American companies operating in Chihuahua and the frontier of Sonora, are said to have requested the Mexican government to establish a system of safe conduct to protect their trucks and automobiles from raiding by bandits, with which system there would be insured safety in transportation of large amounts of gold and silver bullion.

A few days since, in the vicinity of Mazatlan, a great aeolite fell into the sea, near the Isla de Piedra, causing a great commotion in the waters and throwing spray a long distance.

A committee of prominent and well known ladies of both Nogales, has commenced work of solicitation of funds, provisions and clothing to alleviate the distress among the poor of the two towns the coming winter. To assist in the laudable work there will be given in the Hidalgo Theatre a

series of theatrical attractions in which a brilliant array of local talent from both cities will participate, and a kermess will be given in the Plaza Trece de Julio.

A passenger arriving from the south Monday evening reported that on the train going from Guaymas to Mazatlan, one day last week, an attorney named Eudardo Garcia, known well in Nogales, Sonora, where he practiced law a couple of years, was assassinated while the train was passing between Guanochil and Naranjo stations, several persons being implicated in the crime, and four bullets taking effect. He was mortally wounded, and died after reaching Mazatlan. Mr. Garcia had been appointed to the post of judge of the first instance in Sinaloa.

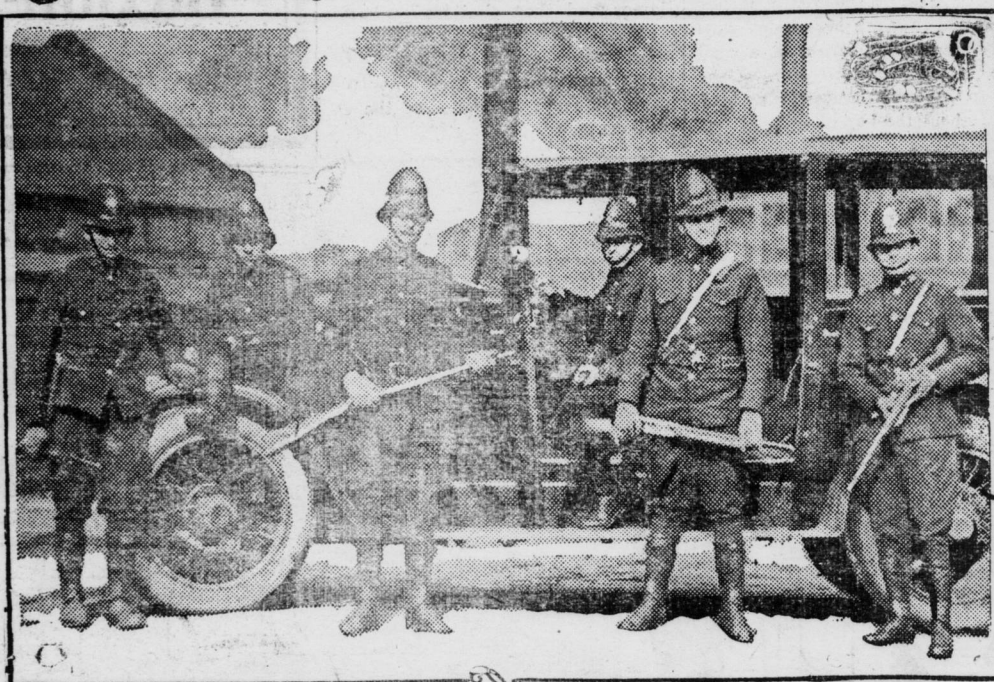
Governor Estaban Cantu, of the Northern District of Lower California, has closed the great gambling house, "Techoote," ("Owl"), at Tia Juana, which has paid in licenses \$3000 per month to the district government.

Mr. Paul Kittewski, representing a large American company, with ample capital, has applied to Governor Cantu, of Lower California, for a concession to establish at Tia Juana, near San Diego, a large brewery, with all modern improvements, to cost one million dollars.
