Mr. Lewis said Judge Rosalsky had already granted McIntyre until June 10 in which to change his present plea of not guilty or take any other steps incident to his defense. The lawyer denied Mr. Train's assertion that the issue was already properly at bar. Judge Foster agreed with Mr. Lewis. He said that since the object of the prosecution was apparently only to get the case on the calendar for a speedy hearing, he would fix June 11 as the date for beginning the trial and 41 neither side was ready by that time he would consider the advisability of granting a continuance.
