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PUTS \$20,000 VALUATION ON WIFE AND MOTHER

Paris Court Awards Damages for Women Killed by Truck. Copyright (New York Evening World) by Press Publishing Company, 1922.

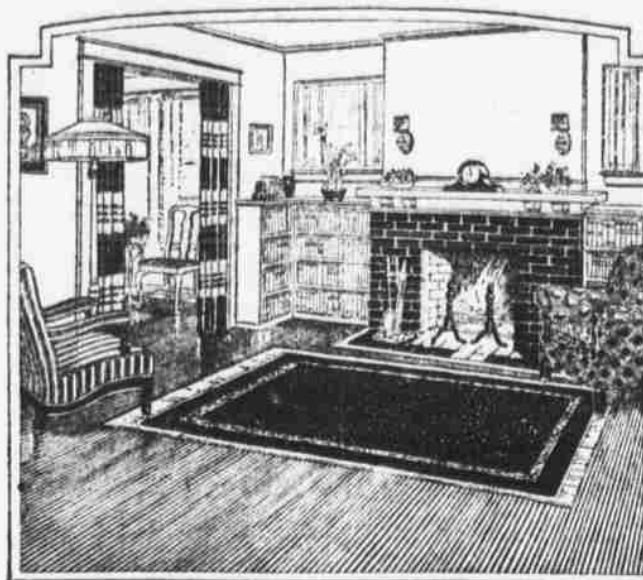
PARIS, March 10.—In confirming a verdict for 100,000 francs, the Court of Appeals presents in financial terms an appraisal of the value of a wife and mother in the home. The case grew out of the death of the Countess of Chabot and Mme. de Vignacourt, who were killed by a motor truck on the

Quai d'Orsay a few months ago. Suit for damages against the owner of the truck resulted in a verdict to two families of 100,000 francs, normally about \$20,000. The truck owner was ordered to pay under the final decision.

The Appeals Court holds that the death of a wife and mother constitutes both a moral and a material prejudice for husband and son. "Woman in the home," the court adds, "is not only wife or mother, but also mistress of the house, and her qualities of order and providence assure good administration of the home."

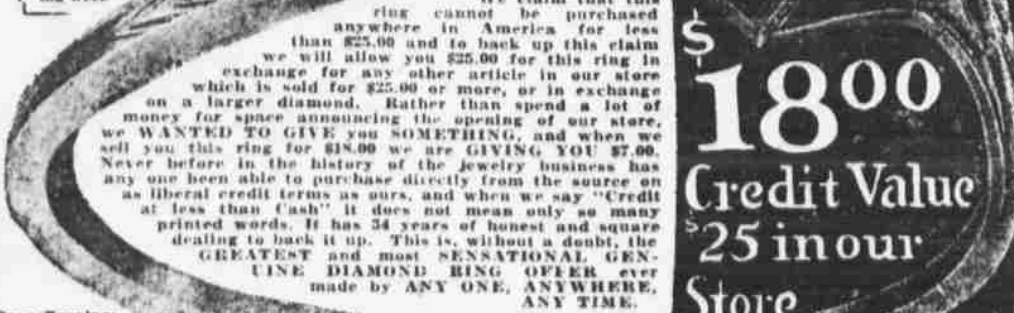
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
