It is strange, with the many men on the existing newspaper press to whom Frank Vietely, one of the numerous victims of Hicks Pacha's unfortunate expedition, was intimately known, that in the comments on the Jubilee number of the *Illustrated London News* which have been taken of that paper's omitting all allusion to its most famous war "special," Frank Vietely furnished "The Illustrated London News" with hundreds of admirable sketches relating to Garibaldi's conquest of the two Sicilies, the French Emperor's campaign for the liberation of Italy, the brief Austro-Prussian War, and the war of Secession in the United States.
