OUTSIDE SECURITIES.

In the late afternoon the market rallied sure. In the late afternoon the market railied slightly in sympathy with the upward turn in the stack market. The mining issues continued the leaders and helped to swell the transactions. A bogus order was given in Nevada-Utah, with the loss falling upon traders. United Copper opened strong, but subsequently broke as sharply. Nevada-Utah fluctuated within a range of 3 point. Butte Coalition broke rather sharply. Trinity Copper, after early weakness, davioped strength. Greene shars were irregular. Nevada Consolidated and Cumporland-Ely were sold rather freely. Other mining shares ductuated in either direction from 14 to 3 of a point. American Writing Paper preferred was weak. Havana Tobacco was down by points. International Mercantile Marine preferred from 5 Subway was active, but irregular. Bonds were dull and about unchanged.
