



TURBAN'S THE THING

The new season's millinery is of unusual interest. There is enough variety and change of shape to please the most exacting. And withal, the shapes are mostly becoming to the average American type of face and head, the which could not be said of the majority of shapes in some of the seasons lately passed.

There are large hats and small hats, or rather turbans. The former are hats for dress occasions mostly, while the smart, close fitting turbans are for street wear almost exclusively. There are large and small tricorne, and a vast number of pretty walking hats with one side turned up in a most bewitching way. Then there is the Kalmouk, or Russian turban, big and picturesque shapes of the first and second empire periods, and lastly, yet most novel of all, shapes that are distinctly of the Louis XV and XVI epochs. With such an assortment to select from the choice is certainly somewhat embarrassing to the woman who can buy one or two of each.

Big wings and birds, coque feathers, vulture,

mercury wings, bands and bows made of feathers, ostrich plumes and aligrettes of every description comprise the styles in feathers. The latest aligrettes are shaped like a palm leaf fan, and many of them have two small mercury wings pored at the base in a most effective manner. The military, or brush, aligrette is a splendid shape for the youthful face.

For ornaments there are big buckles and cabochons made of jet, silver and gold, the antique metal effects being prime favorites. Then there are gold and silver galloons that look slightly tarnished, which are used to decorate some of the most fashionable of the jaunty tricorne hats. A stunning, long haired black beaver hat in this three-cornered shape was seen the other day on Broadway simply trimmed around the edge with a one-inch band of gold and silver galloons, with a huge cockade at the left side made entirely of the narrow galloons.

The pressed shapes in hats are made of beaver, moire and beaver, more faced with velvet, taffeta faced with velvet and all velvet. Also there are hats made of silk plush, the material of which a man's high silk hat is made. So that, besides the new forms, there is quite a variety of materials used in the construction of the hats.

Some of the smartest turbans are trimmed with immense ribbon bows. These are posed rather low at the left side and toward the back, which is a novel arrangement, and one that is quite in keeping with the outline of the new turban. This was a style most popular in the fashionable quarters of Paris during early September and was attractive from its very simplicity.

There is an enormous array of fashionable shades and colors in millinery this season. To enumerate all would be an impossible task. A few of the more prominent ones are suede, passiflore or mauve, Bordeaux, taupe, olive, bronze, iris, lierre green, sphynx, steel and lead blues, blue of the night and national blue. But, even so, the half has not been told.

4.—TOQUE OF GRAY RUSSIAN FOX, with crown of amethyst velvet, ornamented with heads of the same shade. Made by Carlier, Paris.
5.—THE "MARY MANNERING TURBAN," created for the popular American actress by Augustine, Paris. Made of black fox fur, and simply trimmed with the animal's head and tail, and ornamented with a single pink rose.
