East Orange, N. J., Dec. 30.—Vernon L. Davey, for more than thirty-five years connected with the school system of East Orange and for twenty-three years its supervising principal, died at his home, 32 South Munn av., this city, this morning. He had been ill since June.

Born in Groton, N. Y., in 1852, Mr. Davey was graduated from Cornell in 1875, and became principal of the Groton Union School. Three years later he became principal of the Groton Union School.
