CITY COURT LIMIT UPHELD

Highest Court Nullifies Law Giving Jurisdiction Up to \$5,000.

Washington Predictions for To-day and To-morrow.

For eastern New York, unsettled, probably light snow to-day; to-morrow, fair in south, unsettled in north portion; moderate east to north winds.

For New Jersey, cloudy with probably snow to-day; fair to-morrow; moderate winds, mostly north.

NEW YORK, Jan. 28.—The storm which was causing heavy rains over the southern States on Monday passed northeastward and was apparently centered some-where east of Cape Hatteras yesterday.

It was colder in the lake region, the Atlantic States, the upper Ohio Valley and southward into the east Gulf States, with freezing temperatures over the middle sections of the latter States.

It was also colder in the upper Mississippi Valley, but warmer in the central States.

In this city the day was fair and colder, wind, fresh northwest; average humidity, 47 per cent; barometer, corrected to read to sea level, at 6 A. M., 30.95; 9 P. M., 30.99.
