PANORAMA OF JERUSALEM, IN PRINCE STREET.—This beautiful picture is daily visited by all the fashionable and lovely ladies in the city. Stephens, in his new work says—

He has commenced in this city with his Panorama of Jerusalem, and a large circular building, covering an area of nearly ten thousand square feet, has been erected for its exhibition. It was first exhibited at Bedford's, and so great was the sensation created in London, that the first season it was visited by more than a hundred and forty thousand persons."
