Vacation Church School teachers will receive training this year the week of April 18th by attending one or more of the five regional training institutes being planned by the Children's Work Committee of the Cleveland Church Federation.

East Clevelanders will attend the Heights region institute to be held at the Church of the Saviour, Lee and Bradford rds. on Friday, April 22nd from 9:30 a. m. to 3 p. m.

The morning sessions each day will be led by Mrs. Elizabeth Hanna, Director of Religious Education of the Council of Churches of Greater Cincinnati. Mrs. Hanna returns to Cleveland by popular request to help develop the theme: "Personal and Group Relationships". The afternoon sessions will be given to the development of the Cooperative, Judson and Westminster texts for nursery, kindergarten, primary and junior age groups. There will be a group for

ministers and directors of vacation church schools. Texts and materials can be purchased at the institutes.

Church school teachers will be interested in attending the evening sessions being held each day from 7:30 to 9:30 p. m. Mrs. Hanna will give a demonstration with Primary children. A period of evaluation will follow.

Guest Evangelists From Canada Will Conduct Services



Special Evangelistic Services will be conducted nightly at The Salvation Army, April 18th to April 24th with Lt. Colonel and Mrs. Ludwig Ursaki of Canada as the guest Evangelists.

A part of the Salvation Army's great endeavors to help mankind of all the Collinwood Area, the series of Evangelistic Services is open to the public and a cordial invitation awaits your worshiping in the services.

Lt. Col. Ursaki entered the Salvation Army Training College in February, 1907 and was commissioned in July of the same year, with his first appointment as assistant Corps officer of the Lisgar Street Corps in Toronto, Canada. Following this appointment he then Captain and Mrs. Ursaki commanded a number of the larger Corps in Winnipeg and New Brunswick and the famous Montreal Citadel Corps in London, and the Earlscourt Citadel in Toronto, Canada that has presented concerts of sacred music here in Cleveland under the auspices of the Cleveland Temple Corps.

In 1926 Colonel Ursaki was appointed Divisional Young People's Secretary with supervision of the Youth Work of The Salvation Army until his appointment in 1932 as Divisional Commander of the Ottawa Division.

He also served as Salvation Army Chaplain for four and one-half years at the Dorchester Penitentiary in New Brunswick, Divisional Commander for the Northern Ontario Division and Alberta Division, and as Chancellor to the London and Windsor Division.

In January, 1944 the Colonel and his wife transferred to Halifax and prosecuted a strenuous war effort for the service men and women from all parts of the world. Another transfer in 1945 brought the Colonel and his wife to London, Ontario and appointment to the fine British Columbia South Division.

Mrs. Lt. Col. Ursaki entered the Salvation Army work from Charlottetown Corps, Prince Edward Island, in September, 1906. Her first appointment was to the Salvation Army Women's Hospital in Toronto, Ontario, where she graduated as a nurse. Later she was appointed to Winnipeg Grace Hospital as Instructor of Nurses. Lt. Col. and Mrs. Ursaki have an aggregate of over ninety-two years combined Salvation Army Officership and have just

GROUNDWORK FOR WHITE HOUSE EDUCATION CON- FERENCE. The Committee for the

White House Education Conference on Education has started its major planning for the important education meeting to be held in Washington from November 28th through December 1st.

Committee Chairman Neil H. McElroy announced the appointment of seven subcommittees. One of these, the subcommittee on organizations, will work closely with national organizations co-operating with the conference at the state and national level. It will seek the experience of these organizations in dealing with problems of the magnitude of a national education conference.

The other subcommittees will study: (1) What should our schools accomplish? (2) How can we finance our schools—build and operate them? (3) In what ways can we organize our school systems more efficiently and economically? (4) How can we obtain a continuing public interest in education? (5) What are our school building needs? (6) How can we get enough good teachers and keep them?

Conferences in all of the states are well underway or already completed. Their delegates should bring to Washington much that is informative and provocative toward establishing national criteria for improving our educational systems.

According to Pravda, the plant's 350 workers in one year produced three-quarters of a million tons of dolomite, a mineral which has many important industrial uses.

It happens that there is a dolomite plant in Drummond Island, Michigan. When the workers read this story they sent the following letter to Pravda:

"We reached the three-quarter million mark six years ago. Last year we produced over two and a half million tons.

"We are paid immensely better than you are, and we have job security. We can quit any time we want to and move somewhere else. We can own our own homes and vote as we please, and worship God as we please and if we please. Liberty is a great producer of many things, including dolomite."

The Michigan plant has only 200 workers!

NEED FOR BETTER LIBRARIES. All of us concerned with the education of our citizens—especially in the area outside of formal schooling—are awaiting Congressional action on the Library Services Bill, I introduced H. R. 2817, along with 23 other Representatives, to stimulate the further development and extension of public library service to the rural areas of our country.

You will be surprised to know that in our own state, where we are justly proud of our libraries, 850,000 citizens are without local public library service, according to a survey of the Ohio State Library. My bill provides for \$7½ million in Federal assistance to the states for a five year period on a matching basis, carefully safeguarding the state and local library agencies from Federal control. Every American community needs adequate libraries to meet the needs of its citizens, whether to continue education, stimulate good citizenship, contribute to their daily work, or to provide sound material for mental relaxation and stimulation. This legislation should help the states achieve such goals.

What The Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) Believe

The Christian Churches (Disciples of Christ) compose a brotherhood of Christians meeting in fellowship for worship, counsel, comfort and encouragement. They believe in the UNITY of the people of God, RIGHT of personal interpretation in the use of scriptures. SUFFICIENCY of Holy Scriptures for the rule of Christian life. USELESSNESS of all human creeds to test fellowship, feeling them unnecessary and divisive.

OBSERVATION of the ordinance of baptism and the Lord's Supper using the words of Christ as recorded in the Scriptures in Apostolic times. CHURCH government which recognizes the universal suffrage and priesthood of all believers. GOSPEL as a simple message of salvation for all mankind. IMPORTANCE of refusing to impose any tests upon candidates for Christian life, or for any form of Christian service, other than confession of faith in Jesus Christ as the Son of God and Savior of the world as according to Apostolic provision. Each congregation of the Disciples of Christ is autonomous—not subject to a council or any other

authority. Each Church member as a true protestant has the duty and privilege of facing his personal problems and his spiritual problems as his own priest. This is done with the guidance of his own conscience and Christian education and with due regards for the wisdom and convictions of his fellow members.

In the Christian Church the responsibility of operation is vested in an official board consisting of Elders, Deacons and Deaconesses elected by the congregation and subject to the will of the congregation which has final authority. There is no pre-eminence of the clergy over the laymen in the Brotherhood. Membership in the Church is a voluntary act by an individual who bases his faith upon the evidence revealed in the New Testament.

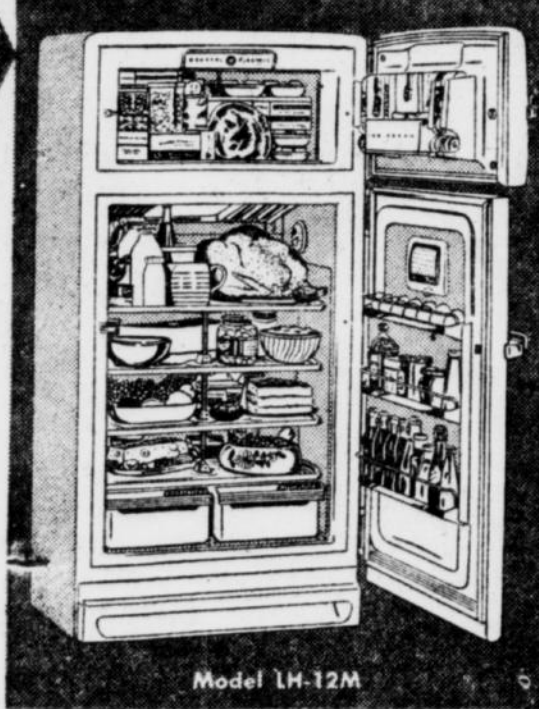

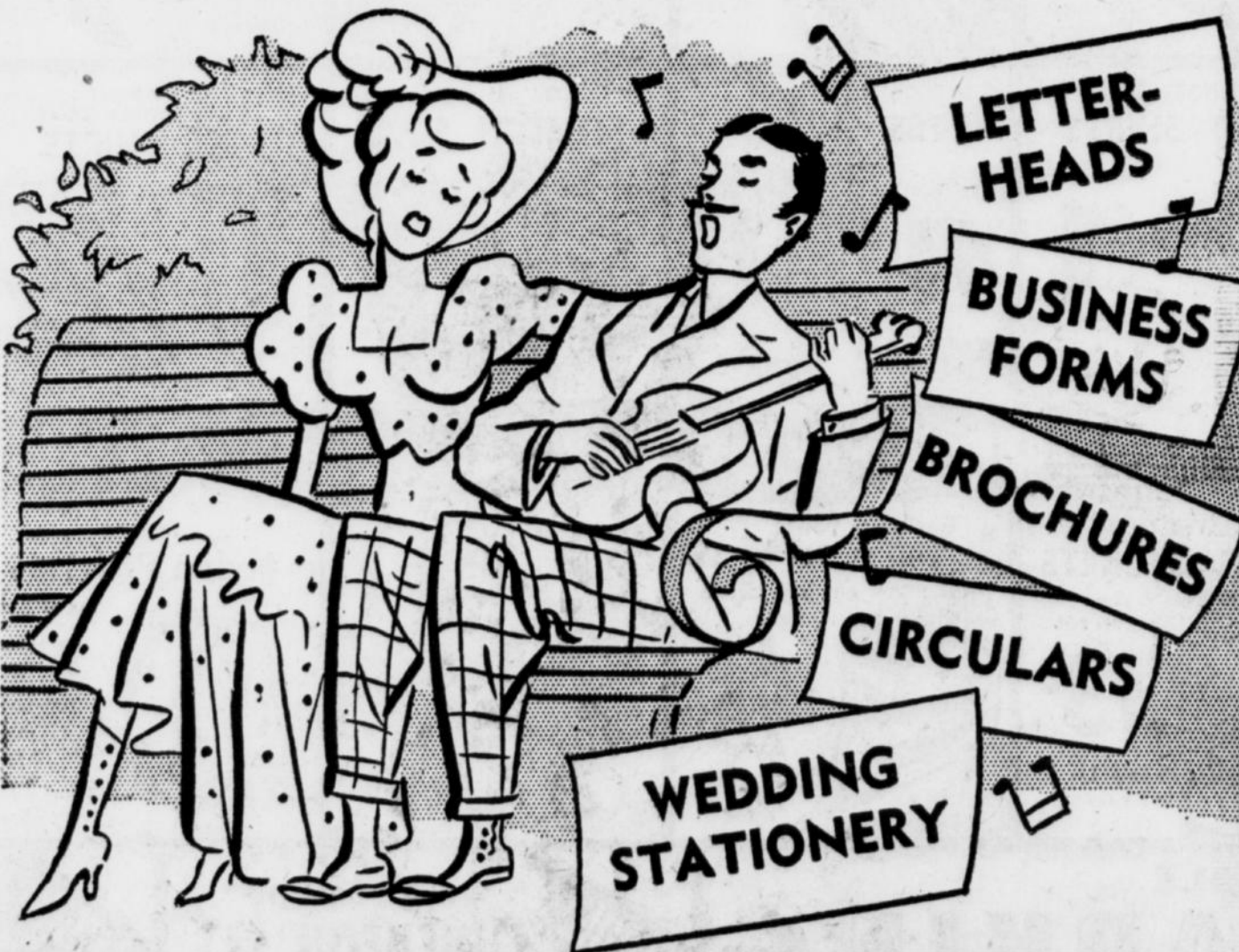
