IS SHIVERING NOW

John S. Bradstreet Finds a Sharp Contrast Between the West Indies and Minneapolis.

Paints an Attractive Picture of His Trip Through Cuba and Jamaica.

John S. Bradstreet would paraphrase the old missionary hymn and make a prophetic change enabling him to sing in shivering tremulo:

From Nassau's coral strand,

From sea bathing in the limpid waters of Jamaica under soft blue skies, to a tremendous fall on the icy sidewalks of Minneapolis is a far cry.

While Minneapolis experienced a below zero temperature Mr. Bradstreet was dallying at St. Thomas, St. Vincent, Grenada, Martinique, Jamaica, Havana and Nassau.

Last evening Mr. Bradstreet told Captain Richmond P. Hobson that he had just visited his famous swimming pool at Santiago de Cuba, and the dungeon where he had been confined. Mr. Bradstreet saw also San Juan hill and after a drive over the worst road he ever saw reached the battlefield of El Caney. At Nassau the captain steamed east fifteen miles to where Jay Cervera's beached and blackened battlehips.

The character of the natives of islands dominated by the British and by the French and Spanish Mr. Bradstreet noticed with interest, the natives of the French and Spanish colonies being of a mixed race, while in the British isles they remain a Nubian black. At Nassau the spoken English of the negroes is pure, as the schools have furnished a fine education.
