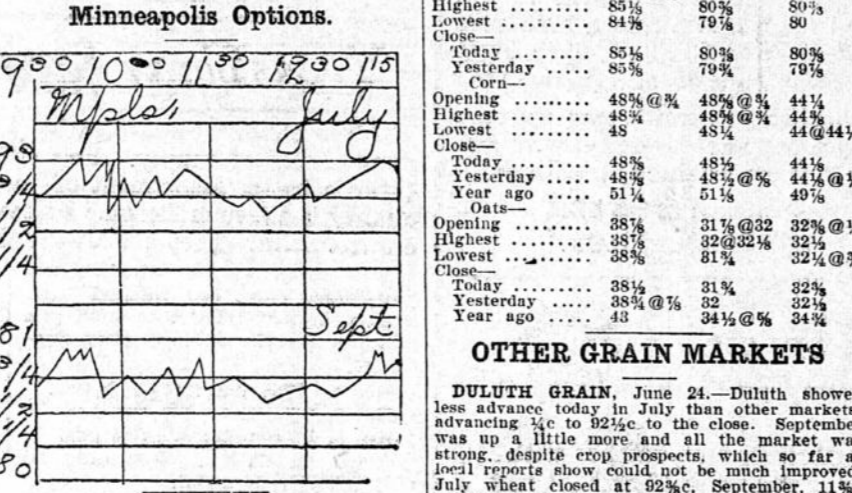

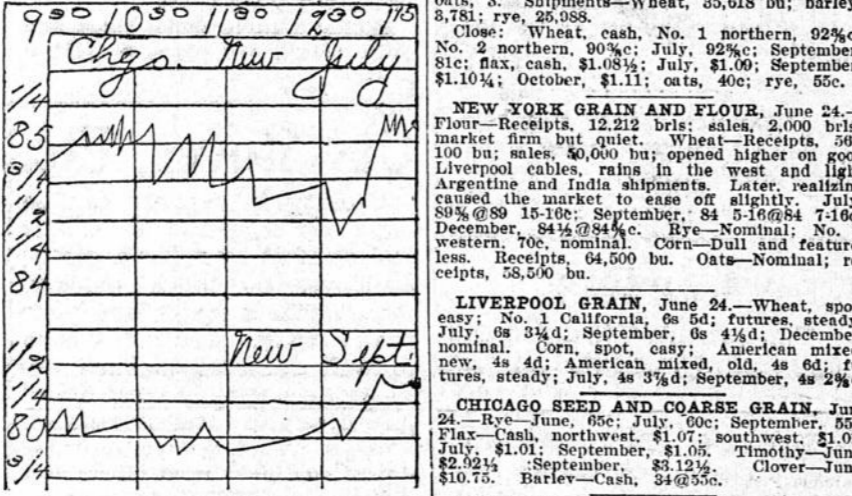

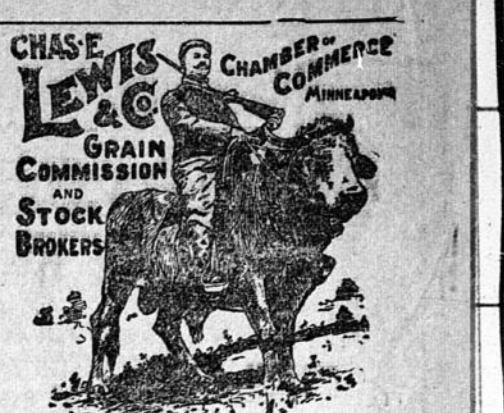
Chicago, June 24—A heavy wind and rain storm passed over this section of the country today.
