DEMOCRATIC SPIRIT PREVAILS IN SCANDIA

PRIME MINISTER'S DAUGHTER WORKS AS BANK CLERK.

Monarchy a Mere Form as Kings Have Scarcely Any Authority - Tourists Have Not Yet Spoiled a People or Created an Obnoxious Class of "Tiphunting'' Servants and Officials.

Ida Husted Harper, who was one of the American delegates to the great woman's suffrage congress at Copenha-gen last month, improved her opportun-ity while across the water to visit the Scandinavian countries. Naturally she found much to interest her and she has sent several interesting letters on her observations in the lands of the Northmen. Following is an extract from her most recent letter:

Altho the numberless streams of Norway are fairly crowded with trout, a chance visitor can scarcely find a place to throw a line, as brooks, rivers and lakes are leased by English sportsmen.

These Scandinavian peoples are a salubrious change from those of the rest of continental Europe—not yet corrupted perhaps, by an annual horde of sightseers. At present railroad, boat, carriage and hotel rates in Scandinavia are fair, and American spendthrifts have not yet raised the prices of native manufactures. Instances are actually known where a tip has been refused!

Monarchical rule in these Scandinavian countries is of the most modified characted. The new king of Norway might as well be one of these royal statues so far as real authority is concerned. The present king of Denmark makes many more concessions to the people than did King Christian, whose reign was noted for liberality.

The general spirit of democracy may be illustrated by the fact that a daughter of a prime minister of Sweden is employed in a bank in Stockholm; also






