London, Dec. 8.—To the unbounded astonishment of British politicians the house of lords has suddenly "flopped" from the extreme conservatism to advocacy of one of the most radical labor doctrines ever laid before parliament. That its sudden change of heart was anything more than a strategem is not for a moment believed. The effect of the supposedly decadent peers' action has been apparently to disconcert their

opponents, however.

To please the laborites, Sir Henry Campbell-Bannerman had the house of commons pass a bill, which, among other privileges for unionism, exempts union funds from attachment. The bill passed the lower house over the opposition of the outraged conserva-tives and despite some mild protests from most of the country's large em-ployers, who, however, kept compara-tively silent on the segments that the ployers, who, however, kept compared tively silent on the assurance that the lords would refuse to sanction what even so moderate a lawmaker as Mr. Dicey terms 'the most revolutionary measure ever introduced into parlia-

measure?

"It was startling," says one American writer in England, "as if Mr. Bryan were to declare the trusts a gift from heaven and the gold standard the nation's priceless heritage."

Some of the older tories were nearly apoplectic in their anger, but the bill passed nevertheless.


