Baltimore Register of Wills' Report. BALTIMORE, January 3.-A comparative statement prepared by Bart E. Smith. register of wills, shows that the receipts of his office from taxes on the commissions of executors and administrators and the collateral inheritance tax were \$44,532 more last year than in 1908. The receipts from this source last year were \$191,712, against \$147,180 in 1906. Last year 1.386 administration bonds were granted and 503 wills were probated, against 1.331 administration bonds grant-ed and 549 wills probated in 1906.

Human Body a Battery. CHICAGO, January 3 .- Dr. J. C. Siebel,

a physician of this city, announced yesterday before the American Association for the Advancement of Science that he has discovered a method of generating energy within the human body. He as-serted that electricity stored in the human body can be released and made to do work. This work, he said, is the prolongation of life through the additional vitality supplied to the human body working as its own electrical generator. Dr. Siebel announced that nutritive ele-

ments such as alcohol, sugar and fats during their consumption by the human body act as generators of electricity in body act as generators of electricity in the miniature batteries that comprise the muscular structure of the human frame.

He declared that he has succeeded in the construction of batteries on a working scale, in which the nutritive element necessary to form the connection between the batteries and the system has been created.
