COOKE GOES BACK TO WORK.

Wants Money Enough to Return East and Set Matters Right.

SAN FRANCISCO, January 8. —Jere Knode Cooke, the well-known preacher from Hempstead, L. I. who, with Miss Floretta Whaley and their child, has been in the vicinity of this city for the last few days, has visited his former flat at 110 Green street and taken away the belongings he was forced to leave in his hurried flight.

When Cooke learned that he would not be arrested and no steps would be taken to separate him from his child and the woman who passed as his wife, he decided to go to New York and give up his trade of painting and decorating here.

Since his discovery in San Francisco numerous persons have shown eagerness to help him. Many clubs took up subscriptions, private individuals came forward with offers of money and about a dozen gentlemen expressed their willingness to care for Cooke and his family.

Cooke said that he was saving enough money to go east and set matters right here, but that he would agree to nothing which might result in giving up Floretta Whaley and his child.
