MAY AID WAR ON THE FLY 3

New Ideas Expected to Be Furnished by Chil-

Health department officials are interested in the contest, for they believe that some of the papers may develop new ideas that will be of value to science in fighting the fly pest. Dr. William C. Woodward, health officer of the District, is one of the judges who will decide on the merits of the essays submitted.

The contest will close next Wednesday, May 15, and the names of the winners, it is expected, will be announced by the latter part of the week. The cash awards consist of two first prizes of \$5 each, two second prizes of \$3 each and two third | %

Inquiries concerning the contest should be addressed to the Anti-fly Campaign Editor of The Star. Essays submitted after May 15 will not be considered.

Contest Is Close.

According to Dr. Murray of the health department, who is supervising the antifly campaign, there has been little change during the last few days in the relative standing of the contestants in that campaign. While a number of new competitors have entered the race, none of them has brought in a sufficiently large num-ber of flies to enable him to displace any of the leaders. There are slight mar-gins between the scores of a number of the children and indications point to a

close finish in the race. The prizes to be awarded by The Star at the close of May to children who kill the greatest number of flies amount, in all, to \$60. The value of the first prize is \$20. Scarcity of flies, say health officials, has prevented the contestants from making big scores, although a number of them have killed several thousand insects.

### Showing Is Encouraging.

"Considering the fact that there have been but few flies this spring, the showing of the contest so far is decidedly encouraging," said Dr. Murray today. "There is no estimating the effect it will have in reducing the size of the fly population ultimately to be developed here this season, except that we know it will be tremendous, inasmuch as the slaughter to 3 date will prevent millions of insects from coming into existence.

"The records of the contestants are being kept up to date, and I will be able to announce the winners the day the contest closes. The present outlook is that the margins between the highest contestants will be represented by a few hundred flies

AID FOR ALLEGED INSANE.

New Organization to Fight Against Wrongful Incarcerations.

NEW YORK, May 9.- The newest organization to apply for incorporation under the New York state laws is "The 3 American Society for the Protection of the Alleged Insane," which aims to save sane folks from being held for insanity. The incorporators state that "many cases where sane persons were pronounced insane, committed to institutions and ultimately discharged after legal fights prompted clergymen, law-yers and physicians to organize this society for the purpose of preventing such niscarriages of justice."

Mrs. Margaret Evans Wright, general Mrs. Margaret Evans Wright, general secretary of the new society, was released from an asylum at Central Islip, L. I., last month after she had convinced the court of her sanity.

"A case in point," says the president of the society, "is that of Mary Elizabeth Lewis, who was detained for twenty-two years in Bloomingdale before she was found to be sane. Another case is that of J. L. Chaloner, who was adjudged insane in this state, and afterward wrote such creditable works as 'Four wrote such creditable works as 'Four Years Behind the Bars of Bloomingdale' and 'Lunacy Law of the World.'"
