James Huffman, Confederate veteran and resident here sixteen years, died at his residence, 1765 Euclid street, yesterday morning, eighty-two years old.

Mr. Huffman was born January 21, 1840, in Page county, Va. In 1866 he joined the 10th Virginia Cavalry, and was wounded in May, 1864; taken prisoner and confined in the Elmira, N. Y., prison until the end of the war. The greater part of his life after the war was spent in Virginia until he moved to Washington about sixteen years ago. He belonged to Camp 171 of the United Confederate Veterans and was a member of the executive committee of that organization at the time of his death.

Mr. Huffman is survived by three sons, G. M. Huffman of Roanoke, Va., O. C. Huffman of Cincinnati, and S. C. Huffman of Chicago, and six daughters, Mrs. A. M. Roush of Weyers Cave, Va.; Mrs. H. C. Beery of Bridge-water, Va.; Mrs. W. D. Brush of Chevy Chase, Md.; and Misses Nora, Mabel and Gertrude Huffman of Washington.

Funeral services will be held at the family residence tomorrow morning at 10:30 o'clock, after which the body will be sent to Staunton, Va., for burial beside his wife, who died many years ago.
