## **Bishop Block Delivers** Sermon at Former Parish

The Right Rev. Earl Block, Bishop of California, yesterday returned to St. Mark's Episcopal Church, his former parish, and delivered a sermon before a welcoming attendance of former and present members of the church. Bishop Block stopped off in Washington while en route to the West Coast from a meeting of the House of Bishops in Jacksonville, Fla.

Among those who attended the services were his sister, Miss Paulina Block, a member of All Soul's Episcopal Church; two brothers, Leonard Block and Theodore Block, and several other relatives.

Bishop Block told the congregation the world was threatened with the loss of its value of the dignity of the human personality through emphasis on material values.

As a youth, he attended Maury Elementary School, Eastern High School and the Virginia Theological Seminary prior to graduation from George Washington University. He was confirmed and ordained at St. Mark's. In 1907 he was in the choir which sang at the cornerstone laying of the Washington Cathedral.




