## Farm Credit Measure Goes to White House; Merges 3 Agencies

Congress has approved and sent to the White House a bill which will consolidate three Government farm credit agencies into a farmers' home administration.

Compromise legislation accepted by both the Senate and House yesterday thus abolishes the 10-year-old Farm Security Administration, the Emergency Crop and Feed Loan Offices and the Regional Agricultural Credit organization.

Representative Cooley, Democrat, of North Carolina, who as chairman of a House Agriculture subcommittee conducted an investigation of the FSA three years ago, said this legislation "will prevent duplications and thus save money manpower."

The Farm Loan Administration, if the President approves the bill, will operate under the Agriculture Department.

The new agency would be on a statutory basis, instead of having to be authorized from year to year as some units being consolidated have been in the past.

The new legislation in effect gives congressional approval to the 10-year-old FSA for the first time. FSA prior to the proposed consolidation

has operated under executive order of the President, although Congress has approved funds for it.

The bill enlarges the farm tenant program with veterans getting priority. Provision is made for farm mortgages guaranteed by the Government, similar to the Federal housing loans now available to city home owners.

Interest on tenant purchase loans and insured mortgages will be reduced from 4 to 3½ per cent by the bill.

## Mississippi Dragged for 11 Believed Lost in Sinking

CARUTHERSVILLE, Mo., July 30.—The Coast Guard used grappling equipment today in search for bodies of the 11 or more persons who are believed to have died in Sunday night's midchannel collision of a Mississippi River ferry and a barge train.

Efforts will be made to raise the four automobiles and one pickup truck known to have been on the

ferry when the flatboat was overturned in the swirling waters 50 yards off the Missouri shore.

A Memphis diver, Charles B. Brown, located at least one vehicle in the river yesterday, but had to wait the arrival of grappling equipment to recover it.

Thirteen ferry passengers were saved. Another, a small boy, died after being hauled to shore.

A special board of inquiry has been set up by the Coast Guard to

investigate the tragedy, termed by one Coast Guard official as "the worst on this stretch of the Mississippi River in 20 years."
