Deny Charge That They're Reds

This piece probably comes under the head of whistling into the wind. It is intended to deplore the practice of shouting, "Communists" at anybody who disagrees with you or at anybody who suggests changing anything that happens to suit you. It is not a very intelligent practice. Being used to attack all sorts of reasonable proposals, it may eventually win friends for communism. The uninformed citizen may begin to think, "If that's communism, communism may not be so bad!"

But the shriekers keep it up. Just as we used to say that "patriotism is the last refuge of the scoundrel," we now can say that the cry of communism is the first refuge of any person who has no argument. An example was offered this week in the Senate committee considering the nomination of Gordon R. Clapp to be chairman of the TVA board. Senator McKellar, making little progress in his opposition to Mr. Clapp, started tossing the epithet about so widely that he eventually included former Senator James Pope of Idaho, one of the TVA directors, among his Red suspects.

It is said the place lies approximately 63° north and 143° east.

Q. What is the Hagia Sophia? K. A. V. Hagia Sophia (Holy Wisdom) is the name of a former Christian church in Constantinople, now a Mohammedan mosque, now a Turkish Aya Sofia and by Europeans generally Santa Sophia or St. Sophia, which is a mistranslation of the Greek original.

Q. Where was the first department store established? S. B. W. A. The modern department store originated in France. The first one was probably the Bon Marche in Paris. The Louvre, Printemps and Samaritaine, also of Paris, followed shortly thereafter. The first department store in the United States was A. T. Q. Where in the Arctic is the memorial to Admiral Robert E. Peary located? J. B. H. A. The Peary Monument is at Cape York in Northwest Greenland. It is in the form of a tall pillar topped with a metal cap and is visible some 30 miles at sea.

Q. Where are the medals for the armed services made? E. V. A. Medals for the Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard and many for the Army are made by the United States Mint. Included are the Distinguished Service Cross, Purple Heart, Distinguished Flying Cross, Medal of Honor and many others.
