### **Compromise to Lift Old Age Payments** Average of 77 Pct.

Benefit payments to 3 million persons now receiving old age and survivors insurance will jump, probably on October 1 or November 1, from about \$66 million monthly to \$117 million under the compromise social security expansion bill.

The House-Senate conference committee released figures vesterday showing how the agreement they have reached would increase by an average of 771/2 per cent payments now being made to reinsured persons.


