Names in the News

(And how to pronounce them.)

Jacques Leger (Zhak Le-ZHEE), ambassador of the French-speaking negro republic of Haiti (HAY-tee) has issued invitations for a reception next week in honor of the President and Madame Magloire (Mah-gloh-AR) who will be on an official visit to Washington.

The ruling Democratic Party of Japan's Premier Ichiro Hata (Ee-CHEE-roh Hah-toh-YAH-mah) has come out in favor of normal commercial relations with Red China and Soviet Russia, while adhering to the basic policy of United States-Japanese co-operation. Japanese sources have also disclosed that Red Poland's ambassador to Paris, Stanislaw Galski (STAN-ee-slav GAY-ves-kee) has contacted Japan's envoy, Kumeo Nishimura (KOO-mah-oh Nee-she-MOO-rah) to ask if Japan was thinking of re-establishing relations with Poland. On the other hand, Transportation Minister Takeo Miki (Tah-KEE-oh MEE-kee) announced that Japan has decided to hold parliamentary elections February 27 in order to get a clear mandate from the people in regard to its policies.

Salah ben Youssef (Sah-LAH-benn Yoo-SEFF), secretary general of Tunisian Neo-Destour (NEH-oh Des-TOOR) Party, stated in Geneva, Switzerland, where he has obtained political asylum, that after five months of negotiations, France seems more than ever determined "to perpetuate the colonial regime in Tunisia." Ben Youssef and his adherents are in favor of complete independence for their country. (All rights reserved.)
