## Fred H. Brown, Ex-Governor Of New Hampshire, Dies

### Former Senator, 75, Held High U. S. Posts Under Roosevelt

Fred H. Brown, 75, the last Democratic Governor of New Hampshire and a former Senator, died yesterday at his home in Somersworth, N. H.

His health forced Mr. Brown to quit his last Federal job as United States tariff commissioner during the Roosevelt administration. He was controller general of the United States from April, 1933, through June, 1940.

A native of Ossipee, N. H., Mr. Brown served one term in the Governor's chair from 1923-4 and one term in the Senate from 1933 to 1939, when he was defeated for re-election by the late Senator Charles Tobey.

As a youth, Mr. Brown played major league baseball for the old Boston National League team. An outfielder, he played in seven games in 1901.

After his brief fling at baseball, Mr. Brown entered the Boston University Law School and passed the bar examination in 1907.

He was elected mayor of Somersworth for nine successive terms, from 1914 through 1923, and was named a United States Attorney during President Woodrow Wilson's administration. His reputation as a mayor helped him gain the governorship, making him the first Democratic Governor elected since 1857.

Mr. Brown was regarded as an authority on public utilities. He fought various utility corporations and their holding companies throughout New England during the latter '20s.

Former President Harry S. Truman, who served with Mr. Brown in the Senate, said last night he was saddened by the death of "this very earnest public servant."

"He was an able and conscientious worker and a fine gentleman," Mr. Truman said.
