New York, April 27.—After an extended conference with John D. Rockefeller, Jr., here today, Congressman Martin B. Foster, chairman of the House Committee on Mines, left Rockefeller's office shortly before 1 o'clock, stating that nothing had been accomplished in the effort to bring about peace in the Colorado strike "war" zone.
