## KAISER DECLARES WAR ON BELGIUM ---ITALIAN ARMY MAY REVOLT

Naval Engagement Reported in North Sea—German-Army of 100,000 Headed Toward French Border to Help Advance Guard.

Chicago banks received from Washington \$54,000,-000 made available by secretary of treasury. Believed financial situation will now be restored to normal.

Brussels, Aug. 4.—Belgium has opened negotiations with France and England for alliance against Germany.

London.—Premier Asquith told house of commons Germany's answer to English note demanding explanation of invasion of Belgium was not satisfactory. War talk loud among members of parliament.

Berlin, Aug. 4.—Placing responsibility for the break directly at France's door Germany today formally declared war on her neighboring republic.
