WAR AGAINST KAISER RESOLUTION BEFORE NEW CONGRESS

**House Organizes for War Session—Clark Re-elected
Speaker—Party Lines Fall Before Patriotism—
President Eager to Read Message.**

Washington, April 2.—Here is the momentous resolution which, if passed as expected, will put the United States into a state of open warfare with Germany.

Chairman Flood of the house foreign committee gave it out, saying he would introduce it as soon as organization of the house is completed:

"Whereas, The recent course of the imperial German government is in fact nothing less than war against the government and people of the United States,
