**CITY WATER RENTALS TO BE FIXED BY ORDINANCE**

**THE CONCERN INSTALLING PLANT RECEIVED ANOTHER PAYMENT FRIDAY.**

Plant Complete in Every Detail Will Cost Approximately \$51,000.00.

At the last called meeting of the city council the American Light and Power company, received \$13,592.52 on their contract price for installing the Mesa waterworks system. The plant will be in working order within a month and the question is arising as to the cost of monthly rentals. This is a detail that will necessarily have to be fixed by ordinance. It is estimated that the prices will be approximately the same as those at Tempe which will be between \$1.50 and \$2.00 for residence supply.

There remains over twenty thousand dollars to be paid the company putting in the plant. The city waterworks, all complete in every detail it is anticipated will cost \$51,000.00.
