TO CELEBRATE PURIM FEAST

Jewish Holiday Falls on Sunday, and Rabbi Ellinger is Coming from Tucson to Address Congregation Emanuel

Purim, the Feast of Lots, is a half-holiday in the Jewish calendar. The synagogue service for this festival is limited to the reading of the book of Esther, upon the story of which the celebration is based.

Purim celebrates the victory of Mordecai, the faithful Jew, over Haman, the grand vizier of the King Ahasuerus, who plotted to destroy the Jew. Queen Esther, it will be remembered, had been elevated to the throne to succeed Vashti who had displeased the king. Esther was a most beautiful and virtuous maiden, and it was through her intervention with the king that the heroism of Mordecai and the villainy of Haman were disclosed to him.

The story of the Book of Esther reads like a novel, and may not have real historical value. Purim means "lots" and the festival is so called because the day on which the destruction of the Jews was decreed, was chosen by lots.

Purim is a time of general festivity among the Jews, and like most festivals of the Jewish calendar, it is a time for the giving of gifts to the poor.

Rabbi E. Ellinger of Tucson, will conduct services and deliver a sermon to the congregation Emanuel at the Knights of Pythias hall at 23 East Washington street at ten o'clock tomorrow morning. All members are earnestly requested to be present, and a cordial invitation is extended to the public.

ARIZONA CANAL IS SOURCE OF FLOODS

By investigating around a little, J. C. Dobbins of Marinette has discovered the cause of frequent high water in the New River wash to be tailings from the Arizona canal. He writes quite fully on the subject to the Chamber of Commerce, urging some action to prevent the almost continual flooding of the wash during the season of heavy flows at the Granite Reef.

Agua Fria, he points out, has a small watershed, and floods are soon drained off, so that this stream does not cut traffic for very long periods. But one can find a fresher in New River most any time. The rule is that irrigators must bridge their artificial streams wherever they cross the public highways, and why should this not be applied here?
