


**NORMAL SCHOOL HAS
SUPERB SEWER SYSTEM**

A sewer system that cost something over \$3000 and that is readily accessible from property within any part of the corporate limits of the town has recently been completed and is now in operation in Tempe. The electro-chemical process of purification has been installed and has already proved itself far superior to any means of sewage disposition that has yet been devised, according to the town authorities.

Tempe some four years ago undertaken the sale of bonds sufficient to construct the badly needed sewage system. Step by step the preliminary work progressed and just about a year ago the thirty thousand dollars of bonds were disposed of and the contract awarded to Taylor brothers. The immense ditching machine employed by the contracting firm, one that opened a trench a foot and a half wide and anywhere from one to eight feet deep hastened the work along materially and within three months after the work was started the last pipe had been placed, the disposal apparatus was in shape, and the system was turned over to the town.

Property owners in the city are now busily engaged connecting their premises with the system. The work at the Normal campus and the city high and grammar schools was rushed during the summer months and by the time the institutions are opened in the fall will be entirely complete.

To the Normal the system is a big nosebleed, the cesspools that were honey-combing the campus have been filled and the sewerage system generally has been remodeled and enlarged and now drains into the one outlet into the city lines.


