CABINET OFFICERS WILL RE-OPEN ROAD CONVENTION HERE

BIRMINGHAM, Ala., Dec. 22.—J. A. Rountree, director general of the United States Good Roads association and the Bankhead National Highway association, after a ten days' absence in Washington to meet a committee of 25 to present invitations to President Harding and cabinet officers, inviting them to attend the annual meetings of the two associations in Phoenix, Ala., at 29, has returned to headquarters of the associations in Birmingham. He is enthusiastic over the success of the committee in securing the promise of cabinet officers to attend the meetings.

President Harding was most cordial in recognizing the committee but he told him frankly that he could not go to Phoenix until later in the summer, when he expected to visit Alaska, but he assured them that he would be pleased to ride over the Bankhead highway at that time. In declining he paid tribute to Senator Bankhead, who he said he would give a positive answer at a later date. MEXICAN CHARGED WITH MURDER AS RESULT OF KILLING

Carlos Reiz, 26 years old, a sheep herder from Wickenburg, is in the county jail awaiting trial on a charge of murder as a result of the fatal shooting of Francisco Olea at Wickenburg last Thursday morning. Reiz was found over to the superior court for trial following a preliminary examination in the Wickenburg justice court Saturday.

According to the story related by Reiz at his examination, he had been gambling at the home of Chico Verdugo, a man about town, in Wickenburg. Liquor was furnished the players during the night's gaming by Verdugo, he claims. An argument arose early Thursday morning, Reiz said, and he shot Verdugo.

REIZ told county officers last night that he had no intention of injuring Olea, who was well known to him and whom he had befriended on many previous occasions. Olea, he said, was mentally incompetent and many Mexican families of Wickenburg had taken it upon themselves to care for him. He and his wife had aided him numerous occasions, Reiz said. Reiz admitted that he was under the influence of liquor when the shooting occurred and that he did not remember distinctly all of the details of the tragedy. He is married but has no children. He was born and reared at Tucson, he told Phoenix deputies.
