

THE PUBLIC LANDS.

(From the Nashville Banner.)

The enormous quantity of 12,000,000 acres of land were granted to the territory of Minnesota by the last Congress, and immense grants of the public lands have been made to the new States generally within the last few years.

The old States are beginning to look with longing eyes to the rich possessions, thus being so partially distributed. It is time that decided grounds were taken upon this subject. It is one of vital interest to every citizen of the old States, and unless promptly decided, it will soon be without the reach of an equitable and fair adjustment.

Democratic politicians will tell us that it is unconstitutional to give the several States a pro rata interest in the public lands, or the income arising from their sale. But this is no argument against the policy we advocate in view of the fact that every session of Congress adds to the enormous appropriations of lands in the new States for railroad, educational, and other purposes.

Democratic politicians will tell us that they are the protectors of the public lands. Protectors, indeed, "such protection as values give them" to lands—covering and devouring them!—Instead of guarding they have squandered them in the most unexampled manner.

They have given away, millions upon millions of acres of lands to the new States for railroad purposes—fifty millions of acres of swamp lands, besides sixty millions for educational purposes in these States, while Tennessee, as well as other old States, has been struggling under heavy taxation in a vain attempt to develop her resources and educate her children.

The following statement in brief shows the manner in which these lands have been protected by democracy—a party which preaches, or has preached, the doctrine that the public lands should be reserved for revenue:

132,000,000 acres sold, money gone to Treat, 11,000,000 " to internal improvements, 41,000,000 " to R. Roads by last Congress, 66,000,000 " to Schools and Universities, 50,000,000 " Swamp lands to States, 45,000 " to Asylums, 280,000 " to Companies and individuals.

These two hundred million acres have been given away to the new States, and only one hundred and thirty-two million sold. In all this the old States have derived no benefit, and democracy has been prating of protecting the public lands!—a such a partial unjust system, as a contemporary pertinently enquires, to be ever kept up!
