

## With Belgrade University Grad At Teaching End

### Pitt Serbo-Croatian Classes Will Commence In September

PITTSBURGH, Pa. — The University of Pittsburgh has announced that it will offer courses in the Serbo-Croatian language, beginning in the Fall (September) of 1958.

The class is scheduled to meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays, 6:20 to 8:00 p.m.

If more than twenty students register, a new class

will be formed and scheduled according to the convenience of the students.

The Serbo-Croatian course will meet the language requirements for students working towards their B. S. Degrees, i.e., it will be a two-year course.

The course may also be taken as an elective, by those who have already met the language requirements.

This course is available to anyone who has at least a high school diploma.

Students that do not work towards a degree would register as a "non-degree". The latter should write before

The course will be taught by Michael Jovanovic, who studied at Belgrade University; Dorchester College, Oxford, England; Columbia University, New York, N.Y., B.S., M.A.; Union Theological Seminary and St. Vladimir's Theological Seminary, New York, B.D.

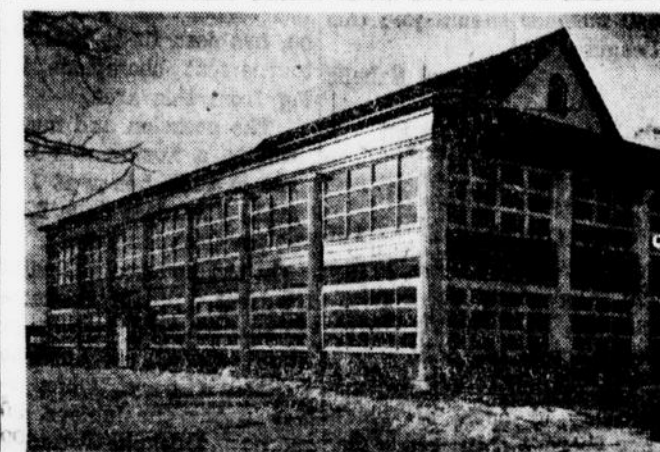
Barbecued lamb, hard and soft drinks, and sweets for the kiddies will be in plentiful supply from noon until the last hours of the outing.
