The loss by the various insurance companies having risks in this town during the last fire, was \$25,000. During the last three years their losses here have aggregated \$60,000. So says an insurance agent.

Within twenty-two miles along the Erie & Pittsburgh Railroad, including New Castle and Sharpsville, there are twenty-four large furnaces and six large rolling mills. These furnaces yield some six hundred tons per day.

The dead body of an infant was found a few days since, in an out-house of the Whistler Hotel, Mercer. Its mother's name is said to be Mary Hunter, and it is supposed that this unnatural creature placed her babe there to perish.

On the 8th inst, while David and Bruton Smith, miners at Pierce's coal shaft, were at work in the mine, a piece of the roofing directly over their heads suddenly fell, striking David on the back, seriously bruising and cutting his back, face, and breast. Bruton escaped without injury.

The following from Oil City Times: A meeting of the Oil Producers of West Hickory and the vicinity of Fagundes, was recently held, and a committee appointed to take action for the protection of producers from exorbitant charges for the transportation of oil on the part of pipe line companies.

A 75 barrel well was struck Tuesday on the Wilkins tract at Fagundes. Another well in the same locality, estimated at between 30 and 40 barrels, was struck on Monday. The latter is owned by Augus McFarland.

The grand social re-union of the Odd Fellows of Venango and adjoining counties, will take place on the 22d-Washington's birthday-at White's Opera House in Roscoeville. It promises to be a very enjoyable affair.

On Saturday last, Major General Kilpatrick was presented, by E. M. McKill Esq., of Roscoeville, with the chestnut trotting horse, "Royal George." The animal is valued at \$2,000.

Captain Travis is making arrangements for a shooting tournament to be held at Titusville Driving Park in the spring, when it is expected some of the best pistol and rifle shots in the country will be present to compete for prizes.

The Corry Republican states that certain parties from Titusville are about to sink an experimental well at Corry, having leased the territory and secured a contract for that purpose.

We take the following from the Titusville Herald: The Union and Titusville Railroad Co. takes out seventeen tank cars loaded with oil this morning. All the freight trains have a caboose attached for the accommodation of passengers, but no regular trains are yet running, as the passenger coaches have not yet arrived.

The new well of Briggs & Andrews, on the Maguire farm, has created no little excitement among the operators, opening up as it does a large amount of territory heretofore considered of no value, and large bonuses have been paid for leases on the farm. Out of compliment to Mr. E. H. Bush, of Buffalo, the well is called the "Medoc Well." Mr. Bush having presented the gentlemen with an elegant flag for it, decorated with a horse, representing the famous "Medoc," one of the winners of the double team race at Buffalo, two years since.

Thursday morning about two o'clock, Mr. James Mullet, clerk at the Empire House, was awakened by some person or persons attempting to break into the room in which he sleeps on the first floor of the house. Coolly taking up a revolver lying by the side of his bed, he blazed away in the direction of the noise, but unfortunately the villain was shorter than he had counted on and the ball passed over his head and through the window, lodging in a wall, the burglar making his escape. Ever since the attempt at burglary made last summer on the Empire House, Mr. Mullet has been prepared to give the villains a warm reception, and he has the will to do it. We would suggest however, that when gunning for game of this description he lower his aim, for the aim that will reach a short man will prove just as effective on a tall one.—Corry Telegraph.

ANOTHER HORRIBLE CASUALTY.—About half-past nine o'clock yesterday morning, an accident resulting in the instant death of a brakeman named Charles Boons, occurred on the Oil Creek Railroad at Roscoeville. It appears that the up train, a second-class one, due at that place at 9:37 a. m., had just arrived but not stopped, when the brakeman leaving a brake that he had set on the forward end of a coal car, was thrown off his feet by an unexpected start of the locomotive, which at the same instant broke the coupling, and the cars parting, he fell between them and was run over and terribly mutilated; in fact nearly cut in two by several of the remaining cars of the train. He was pulled out before the train stopped, but died instantly. The case appears to be a purely accidental one.—Titusville Courier, Feb. 14.
