

FINES SON ONE CENT
FOR BEATING FATHER

Judge Declares Boy Was Right In
Thrashing Parent for Striking
His Mother.

YORK, Pa., Sept. 3.—William Brillhart, who was charged with assault and battery, by his father, was fined 1 cent in Judge Bittlinger's court.

Brillhart pleaded guilty to administering a thrashing to his parent, and told the court that he was defending his mother, whom his father had attacked.

After the judge had reprimanded both father and son for their conduct, he commended the younger man for defending his mother, and fined the prisoner 1 cent and told him he was released.

The judge remarked that if he were thirty years younger he would have administered a whipping to the elder Brillhart himself for beating a woman.
