Culberson Against Lorimer.

It is taken for granted about the Sen-ate that Senator Culberson is inclined to line up against Lorimer. Should Sena-tor Railey make an open fight for Lorimer, political gossip here is that his enemies in Texas will seize on it as a enemies in Texas will seize on it as a reason why he should not be re-elected. Senator Kayner's friends expect him to take a stand against the seating of Lorimer. He has not given it out what he will do, but his friends believe he will take substantially the position taken by Senator Frazler in his statement wherein he held seven members of the Illinois Legislature were tainted and thus the election of Lorimer invalidated.

A long-drawn-out fight over the Lorimer report is now looked for in the Senate. While there has been hitherto talk of disposing of it speedily, it is now thought this will be found impossible. Those Senators who think all the facts should be aired are now saying they are not going to let the report be rushed through. The fight may drag along for weeks.

It is pointed out that already there much public sentiment aroused against the seating of Lorimer. If those who are opposed to him in the Senate make speeches on the floor which get out to the country it is likely sentiment will be still further aroused. Under the circumstances, there is no


