

## MEXICAN REBEL LEADER DEMANDS TOWN SURRENDER

Aguilar, Released by Government on Bail, Surrounds Orizaba.

Gen. Higinio Aguilar, spurred on by the success that has attended his revolt in southern Mexico, today surrounded the town of Orizaba and has demanded its surrender.

Orizaba is one of the richest towns in that section of the republic, and its stores would be a valuable prize for the former brigadier general, who was arrested some time ago accused of plotting against the Madero government, but who was released on bail.

Aguilar has captured a number of towns in the vicinity of Vera Cruz, and has the advantage not attained by Orozco and other revolutionary leaders, of having a seaport under his control.

He is following the same tactics so popular with the insurgent leaders who preceded, that of destroying railway bridges and interrupting communication with interior towns.

At several points in the mountains of Esperanza the rebels have dynamited the tracks of the Mexican railway. They are said to have seized a quantity of dynamite which is being used to advantage.

Gen. Felix Diaz, nephew of the former president, is also in the field against the government, and officials here realize that any revolution he may lead will be on a much higher plane than the unorganized bandit operations of Orozco in the north and Zapata in the south of the republic.

Diaz, who at present is operating in the state of Puebla, is recognized as one of the ablest men in Mexico, and is decidedly pro-American. Aguilar, who is also a power among certain classes in Mexico, would prove a valuable ally to Diaz should they join forces.

The State Department here is keeping in close communication with its agents in that part of Mexico infested with the latest members of the Insurrection.

It is believed that General Diaz will imitate, as far as he can, the example of his uncle, who fought his way to the presidency when Mexico was in the throes of just such general confusion as now exists.

Ambassador Henry Lane Wilson has not yet reported the details of the killing of Herbert L. Russell, the American who was slain September 29 by a band of rebels under Luis Caso, in Durango. Federal cavalry are searching for the murderers.

## WILL CALL MILANO'S WIFE AND DAUGHTER

To Testify To Movements of Italian Charged With Smith Lad's Murder Year Ago.

Tony Milano, the Italian shoemaker, charged with the murder of twelve-year-old Harry Elton Smith, whose charred body was found in his shop after an alleged incendiary fire had been extinguished, will be placed on trial before Justice Stafford in Criminal Court, No. 1, on October 14.

Milano has been in jail since September 10, 1911, the day after the crime is alleged to have been committed. An absolute denial of the charge, which is based on circumstantial evidence, will be Milano's defense.

Justice Stafford today granted a motion of Attorney James F. Kelly and Daniel W. Baker, counsel for the accused, to summon Mrs. Milano and her daughter from Brooklyn, N. Y., at the expense of the Government. It is desired to prove certain facts about Milano's movements on the day of the Smith boy's death.

District Attorney Clarence R. Wilson and Assistant Prosecutor S. McComas Hawken will prosecute the case.
