New Orleans, La., Nov. 3, 1896.

Indications point to Bryan carrying the State by 20,000 to 40,000.

#### McKinley Beats Bryan at Home.

Virginia 83 out of 1500 precincts, Bryan 10,461, McKinley 9991, Palmer 2322.

#### Republican Victories Exceed All Estimates—Altgeld Defeated.

New York, Nov. 3, 1896.

1320 out of 1392 districts. New York City, McKinley 146,660; Bryan, 126,913; Palmer, 5,403. This gives McKinley about 20,000 plurality. New York Tribune has telegram from Mr. Hanna which says: "Results exceed all estimates." Tribune also says: "Altgeld concedes his defeat in Illinois."

673 Districts outside of New York and Kings County gives Bryan 67,385, McKinley 111,028, Palmer 1,405. Same Districts in 1892 gave Cleveland 76,116, Harrison 92,185.

Boston Republican candidates for President and Governor carry every city and town for first time in history of State. Twelve Republicans and one Democrat elected to Congress. Legislature strongly Republican. Majority in State will be 150,000.

#### The Old North State in Doubt.

Chairman Holder claims State for McKinley by 48,000, and later returns put the State in doubt.

#### Bryan Carries Utah.

Salt Lake, Utah, Nov. 3rd, 1896.

Indications, Bryan carries the State by at least 10,000.

#### Kentucky's Gone.

Chairman Republican of State Committee claims Kentucky for McKinley by 25,000.

#### Regular Landslide.

Columbia, S. C., Nov. 4, 1896.

Filed 9 a. m. Everything looks like a Republican landslide although Chairman Jones says there is no foundation for the Republican claims and that there is no reason to say that the States claimed for Bryan have not gone for him. He concedes defection in Kentucky. The reports all indicate McKinley's election by large majority. New York for McKinley by over 25,000, Maryland Republican by about 20,000, West Virginia and Michigan Republican, Chicago goes Republican by 50,000 and that carries Illinois for McKinley, although its not given up for Bryan. Tennessee is doubtful and so is Texas and Nebraska.

The Republicans are congratulating themselves on what is regarded as a McKinley sound money landslide. Charleston voted Bryan 1,486, Palmer 526, McKinley 1,185.
