**COUNCIL DELIBERATIONS**

The city council met last night in regular session, with the following members present: G. S. Scott, Dr. Delouest, E. T. Helvenston, William Hocker, G. A. Carmichael, W. J. Edwards and J. H. Livingston.  
Petitions were read from citizens of the different wards, asking that the gentlemen mentioned in the several petitions become candidates in the city election, which comes off in December. R. E. Yonge, Sr., from the second ward, with 35 names of qualified electors of said ward on the petition. D. W. Davis is the retiring councilman from this ward and G. S. Scott holds over. Judge R. McConathy from the third ward, with fourteen names. Judge McConathy is the retiring member from this ward and E. T. Helvenston holds over. T. J. Owens from the fourth ward, with 29 names on the petition. Dr. Delouest is the retiring member from this ward and G. A. Carmichael holds over. E. C. Smith was nominated from the first ward by mass meeting of citizens of his ward, assembled at the city building, and W. Hocker as chairman and J. P. Moody as secretary of such meeting, certified to the fact. William Hocker is the retiring member from this ward and W. J. Edwards holds over. A petition was filed containing 42 names, asking Dr. T. D. Crawford to accept the position of mayor.  
The fact that this was the time in which petitions should have been presented to the council was overlooked until yesterday, and those gotten up were done hurriedly and thus the number of signers was less than would otherwise have been the case and the number of petitions was probably less. The council decided, however, that today might be used for the purpose, so others may be presented to the clerk tonight, and Judge McConathy's petition will have the requisite 25 names or more.  
S. E. Rowe and George Cleveland were employed to fill the vacancies on the police force.  
The offices of street commissioner and sanitary inspector will be merged into one on the first of December and Messrs. D. Williams and Jas. Duffy will be retired and it is understood that M. F. Dodson, formerly of this city, but recently of Jacksonville, will be employed to fill the position at a salary of \$40 per month.  
On motion of Mr. Helvenston the marshal was instructed to employ a man for ten days at a stipend of \$1 per day to impound dogs found at large without a license tag. Mr. Helvenston said that complaint was heard of the condition of the cemetery. The matter was referred to the cemetery committee, with instructions to report at the next meeting. Mr. Helvenston said the law relative to securing a permit before a body was interred should be enforced. Mr. Helvenston introduced a lengthy ordinance, which passed its first reading, amending the ordinance creating the fire department in several particulars, the principal one being that the chief shall be a salaried official and required to give all of his time to the department and remain at the station, unless engaged on other business for the city, and that he be elected as other officials are, on the first Tuesday in January next and every year thereafter.  
An ordinance was introduced by Mr. Hocker requiring any city bill poster to pay a license of \$10 per annum, same to take effect ten days after passage of the ordinance. This also passed its first reading.
